Benjamin's first Co2 pistols (Models 250/252/257) were of impressively solid construction, boasted a black-nickel finish over brass, and used eight-gram disposable Co2 cartridges.

No typo; I can't explain why the 7.3 grain JSB pellets were slower than 7.9 grain Premiers.
