Course of fire: There will be ten lanes, each lane will have two reaction targets. Participants will engage each target twice. Targets will range from 20-100 yds. There are two types of targets that will be used: knockdowns and spinners. Each knockdown target has a "kill paddle," where if hit, the target will fall. Airgunners will earn 1 point per target that is knocked down. If the target does not fall, no point will be awarded. For spinner targets, if the target plate moves, that is a hit and participant earns a hit. Those that have earned the highest amount of points will win the competition!

EQUIPMENT

WHAT SHOULD YOU BRING?

- Air tanks
- Air rifle
- Pellets
- Sweater/jacket in case of rain
- Hat
- Bug spray
- Safety glasses
- Ear protection
- Camping chair
- Preferred stool or seat for shooting "bucket and stick" style events
- Preferred shooting sticks
- Preferred drinks and snacks
- Any other personal equipment you use at competitions. Please review "RULES" page to assure appropriate equipment will be used in order to avoid disqualification

WHAT WILL BE PROVIDED?

- There will be a couple of air tanks available for general use, however, it is recommended that shooters bring their own
- There will be an air compressor on site
- Doughnuts & coffee, Lunch, and Drinks
- A bucket, stool, and shooting sticks will be stationed at every lane. If you have a preferred seat and/or sticks, it is suggested that you bring them with you
- Tall shooting sticks that will be stationed in the forced position lane (if MD chooses to have a mentioned lane)

RULES

- Only .177 - .30 caliber airguns are allowed
- Maximum 100 ftlbs of energy
- Pellets only (no slugs/bullets may be used)
- No tripods
- No rear rests
- Only unattached bipods and shooting sticks may be used:
 - NOTE: hog saddle style shooting sticks (such as the BOG Deathgrip) longer than 1 3/4 inches are not allowed
 - bipods must be limited to 2 inches from front to back
- Scope magnification maximum of 32x (scope CAN have a higher magnification, but must be dialed back to the nearest marked number that is below 32x)
- This event is timed per MD's discretion, however, it is encouraged to follow this timeline:
 - Shooters have one minute to prepare when it is their turn to shoot
 - Shooters have 30 seconds to engage target (or in other words, 30 seconds per shot)
- Final scoring will be done by staff
- No challenging of targets or scoring by league/club staff. If the target falls, it counts. If it does not, no point will be allotted... PERIOD
- A single seat may be used, i.e., bucket, chair, stool, bum bag, or cushion
 - No chairs with backs or arm rests are allowed
- No shooting jackets, harnesses, slings, etc. are allowed
- There may be a forced position lane, up to the discretion of MD. However, "bucket & sticks" position should be encouraged and used as much as possible
- MD's will decide how "ties" are settled from 1st-5th placement
- Awards will be presented per MD's discretion
