



Normal magazine position is not optimum for me (and possibly other left-handed shooters).

A one piece shorter and ambidextrous cheek weld creates a platform for both left and right handed shooters. Rear mounting hole (and screw) from factory weld are used.



At least for me the upright magazine position does not interfere with scope alignment or eye relief.



With the shorter cheek weld attached behind the magazine port, the magazine can be inserted (and functions properly) in either the original (right-handed) or a more upright position. Inserting the magazine in the upright position is far more conducive to MY shooting position. This position puts the majority of the magazine on the left side of the gun allowing space for the left-handed shooters nose (a complaint noted in some reviews of the Maverick).
