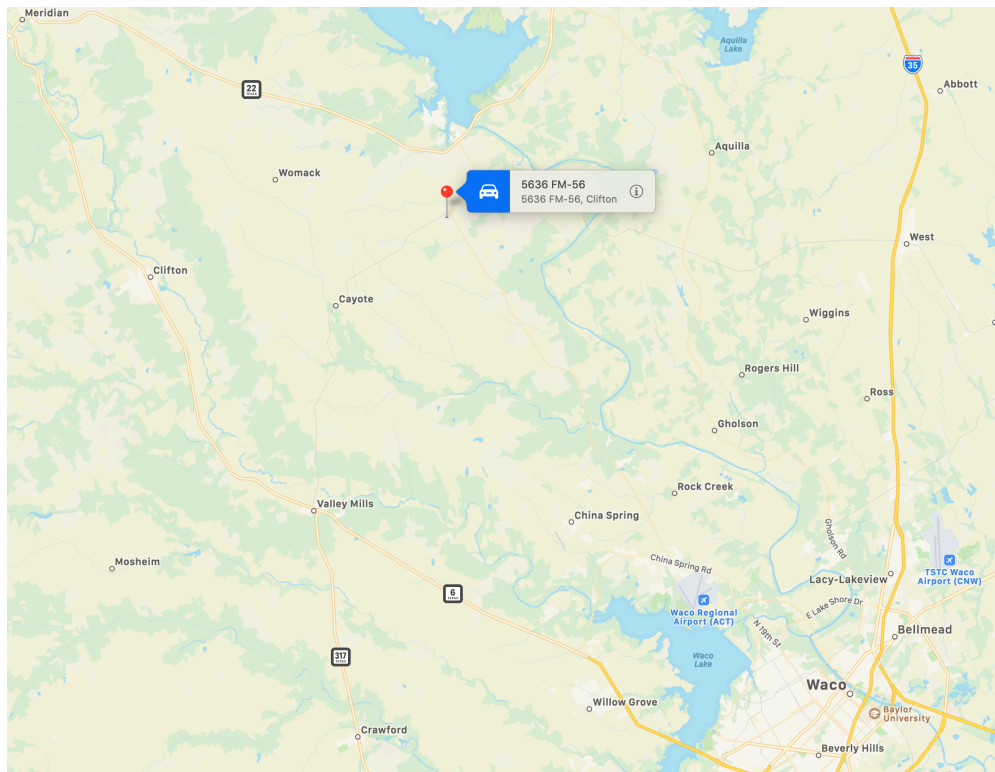

Match location- The address is 5636 FM 56, Clifton, Tx. 76634. It's at the intersection of FM 56 and 2490; 4 miles south of the Lake Whitney dam, 30 minutes NW of Waco.



Sight-in/practice- All sight-in and practice will be from a covered back-porch/deck with four ambidextrous shooting benches. Shooters will shoot from the benches and/or sitting on the deck, depending on match schedule and safety concerns. Targets and/or steel backstops will be 20, 40, 50, 60, 77 and 100 yards from the firing line.



Match Courses- The Bench-Rest Silhouette course is shot from the wooden benches on the covered back porch described above, at four banks of 1/10 scale animal silhouette swingers at ranges of 40, 60, 77 and 100 yards; for a total of 40 shots for record. All silhouette matches will be shot on shooting lanes around the 30 acre Ranchito Robinson venue. Some silhouette shooting boxes are shaded, others are not. Extreme field target distances are at least 20 yards minimum, to no more than 100 yards maximum. Pistol/Fun-Rifle field target distances are at least 10 yards minimum, to no more than 55 yards maximum, with a 20 foot-pound power limit. Difficulty factor in the Pistol/Fun-Rifle field target match will be suitably extreme for pistols; on the low side of rifle Troyer Factors (mid 20s, not adjusted for wind multipliers). All field target matches will feature two shots at each of 20 targets, for 40 shots total. All field target matches will have the target distances posted at every shooting line.

Scoring- Scoring for all matches will be “X” for field targets felled or silhouettes hit, and “O” for field targets that don’t fall and silhouette misses.

Classes and Awards- The TEXtreme Field Target and Bench-Rest Silhouette matches will both have classes for 100 Foot Pound maximum and 35 Foot Pound maximum. Shooters may enter only one class in any match. TEXtreme Field Target Champion awards will be awarded in all matches and classes with at least five entrants contesting the class, other than Fun Rifle Field Target (which has no awards). Classes with at least eight entries will also have second-place awards. Ten-in-a-row hat-pins will also be awarded in the Bench-Rest Silhouette match.

Entry Fees- A \$60 Tournament fee includes entry in every weekend match and activity. Otherwise, individual match entry fees are \$20 per class, per match.

Registration and Payment of Match Fees- The Match Director reserves the right to limit number of entries in any match or matches, and/or full Tournament registrations as safety, match, and venue capacities dictate. Consequently pre-registrations take precedent over match weekend registrations. Any such closure of registrations will be publicized on the Airgun Nation forum and the TEXtreme Field Target email list. Registration forms may be completed and returned in advance. All attendees will be required to sign a liability waiver immediately upon arrival at the venue.

Equipment related information- Due to proximity of neighbors, all matches will be diabolo pellets only; no slugs allowed. Since the TEXtreme Field Target and Bench-Rest Silhouette matches include targets to 100 yards, likely in challenging wind conditions, similar rifles and scopes are appropriate for both matches. But whereas smaller calibers have a slight advantage in field target competitions virtue of their slightly better ability to *swish* through small kill-zones, larger calibers have a slight advantage in silhouette competitions due to larger-diameter pellets catching the edges of silhouettes that smaller pellets might not touch. Oh, it's reality; trust me!

General Rules and Responsibilities- SAFETY is the first, foremost, and omnipresent consideration at TEXtreme Field Target at all times! Unsafe gun handling will not be tolerated or excused, and will result in expulsion from the venue. Rules exist to insure a SAFE, fair and level playing-field for all. Entry in any match assumes the shooter accepts responsibility for knowing and understanding the rules of safe gun-handling, fair play, shooting and match etiquette. Because all rules are rendered utterly moot by non-enforcement of any rule, and non-enforcement cheats every shooter invested in the contest, all stated rules will be strictly enforced without exception or wiggle-room. Non-adherence to any rule is grounds for disqualification. Shooters are advised to ask the Match Director for clarification of any rule not well understood, always err on the side of safe gun-handling caution at all times, and keep their rigs comfortably within rules parameters and power limits.

Shooting and Equipment Rules- Other than the addition of a 35 Foot Pound (maximum) class, the Extreme Field Target matches will follow the rules-set being used in Arizona monthly EFT matches (those rules attached below). Other than a 20 foot-pound power limit, the Pistol EFT/Fun Rifle FT match will generally follow the AAFTA handbook rules found at AAFTA.org. In situations not covered, the Match Director will have final say; said Match Director driven by logic, reason, fair play, and simplicity.

Mission and Rules for Extreme FT:

To further the sport of Extreme Airgun Field Target Shooting in the United States by encouraging gentlemanly conduct, safety, fairness, and participation by all members.
To promote airgun shooting as a healthy and recreational activity to the general public.

Extreme / American Hunter FT Division:

The Hunter Division rules are intended to promote accessibility to the sport of Field Target, and the use of typical hunting equipment. As such, the rules shall enforce limits on the type of allowed equipment, and shall allow for a broad range of competitor physical fitness and conditioning.

Equipment :

- Rifles shall not exceed .30 caliber or 100 ftlbs. of energy.
- Measured at the muzzle. (EX: 50gr. @945FPS = 99.17 ftlbs.)
- AMMO: any mass manufactured pellet or slug
- For end depth is limited to a maximum of 6 inches, measured from the center of the barrel to the lowest part of the rifle forward of the pistol grip.
- No shooting jackets, harnesses, straps ,slings or shooting gloves that restrict movement can be worn.
Shooter will not be allowed to wear any braces under their clothes that may restrict his/her body movement.

Sights :

- Optical sights of any reticle style may be used, but are limited to a maximum of 25 power magnification. Variable scopes of greater than 25X must be turned to the 25X or nearest lower factory marking on the scope. You can adjust down but NOT up past 25x. Any adjustments made to be verified by fellow shooter.
- Windage & Elevation adjustments are allowed, as is holdover.

- Optical sights with parallax adjustment may be adjusted so that the target is in focus. Range (yardage) markings may be used.

Shooting

- A rifle sling attached to the rifle may NOT be used.
- Adjustable components on the stock may not be adjusted during a match. No butt hooks or add-on thigh-rests are allowed.
- Only (CLUB APPROVED) monopods, shooting sticks, or bipods may be used. Any such aids must rest on the ground and may not be driven or otherwise embedded into the ground or shooting pad, and cannot be attached to the gun: must release from the gun as the gun is picked up, and must not connect to the gun with studs or devices that restrict gun movement. A single stop may be used in front or behind the gun support, but no other anchoring mechanisms are permitted.

Seating

Any form of seat without back or arms support may be used, but the seat may NOT be used to support the gun while shooting.

Format:

- Targets will be placed from 20-100 yards
- All target distances will be given
- Each shooter will have 4 minutes to shoot 2 targets twice for a total of 4 shots per Lane/station.
- Kill zones will be various shape and sizes
- Air will be provided on the course with Female foster fitting (you must supply own fitting with male connect)
- Shoot offs (top 3 only) may be shot on small bore range. will be match to match, decided by shooters.
- Ties otherwise will be settled 2 ways:
- Longest Streak or First miss to be decided at each match.
- Match director will be final vote in any tie or undecided topic.
